Does Aristotle make a distinction between good and bad use of one's mind? It seems to me that if one is using his mind wisely and using it in a manner that fosters his development, it would be to one's advantage and would be good. If, on the other hand, a person is using his mind for a bad purpose, like a fool or a maniac, it is to their disadvantage and it would be bad. Is Aristotle's distinction between good and bad in terms of these above two categories? A: Aristotle, unlike Plato, had no theory of Ideal Forms, that is, the human soul is a material body, there are no immaterial, non-material or spiritual properties of the soul. Also, unlike Plato he saw the soul as the seat of all human faculties, insofar as it is something that is separable from the body and has its own immediate object (cf. Phys. 4, 211a29). The reason why Aristotle understands cognition and pursuit of its objects as the key principle of all mental activity is rooted in his physics. The principle of all natural motion is to return to the point of departure (cf
